



Church Schools Admission Process

Welcome to St Michael's. We are an open and welcoming Church, with an emphasis on young families. Its great that you have decided to join with us.

The Church of England and joint CofE/Roman Catholic Secondary Schools are among the best in the city. It is good that you are thinking of applying for a place at one of these schools for your child. Church Schools operate a points-based system, for which a reference is provided by the Vicar, according to the following criteria:

1. WE INVITE YOU TO OUR SUNDAY WORSHIP. According to Church School guidelines, attendance at Sunday worship/services is required, for both yourselves as parents and for your child. Expected attendance is three Sunday's per month over a three-year period. Children can attend Children's Church in the Church Hall or to sit with their parents, other than on All Age & Parade Sunday's, when we are all in together. There is a creche for under-4's at the back of the Church. The creche is supervised.
2. WE INVITE YOU TO TAKE PART IN THE LIFE OF THE CHURCH. Church is a serving community, and we would encourage you to become an active part of the St Michael's community.
3. WE INVITE ALL PARENTS TO AN, 'SO, WHAT IS THE CHRISTIAN FAITH?' EVENING
4. WE INVITE YOU TO BE MEMBERS OF ST MICHAEL'S. You may like to formally join St Michael's Church, by signing the Electoral Roll (see Rob Johnson, Warden).
